RESOLUTION 86-71

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH TO PROCEED WITH THE CONTRACTS FOR THE ARCHITECTURAL AND PROJECT MANAGEMENT SERVICES AND CONSTRUCTION FOR RENOVATIONS OF SOLDOTNA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, Resolution 86-37 approved construction documents and statement of probable cost prepared by Architect McGlothlin Balivet and authorizing the bidding phase for the Soldotna elementary project; and

WHEREAS, competitive bids were solicited and opened by the Kenai Peninsula Borough Finance Department on April 22, 1986 at 2:00 p.m.; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with award of contract to Janssen Gorsuch Construction Co. in the amount of \$2,732,940 for construction and renovation of Soldotna elementary school.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with award of contract to Architect McGlothlin Balivet in the amount of \$126,604 for construction phase services.

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with award of contract to project management services, MorrisonKnudsen Co. in the amount of \$100,614 for construction phase services.

Section 4. That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with utility services agreements and testing services and other services as required for completion of the Soldotna elementary school.


Section 5. That they Mayor is authorized to execute all documents and make all agreements deemed necessary to complete this project in accordance with this resolution and project appropriations.

Section 6. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
