KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 86-74

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH TO PROCEED WITH THE CONTRACTS FOR THE ARCHITECTURAL, PROJECT MANAGEMENT SERVICES AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE 1985 SCHOOL BOND PROJECT, CENTRAL PENINSULA HIGH SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, Resolution 86-41 approved construction documents and statement of probable cost prepared by architect Maynard and Partch and authorizing the bidding phase; and

WHEREAS, competitive bids for construction of Central Peninsula High School were solicited and opened by the Kenai Peninsula Borough Finance Department on May 18, 1986;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with the award of contract to Unit Co. Fluorin the amount of \$20,694,000 for the construction of Central Peninsula High School, including Alternates 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with award of contract to architect Maynard and Partch in the amount of \$522,380 for construction phase architectural services.


Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with award of contract to Morrison-Knudsen Co. in the amount of \$678,597 for construction phase, project management service.

Section 4. That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with utility services, testing services and other services as required for completion of the Central Peninsula High School project.


Section 5. That the Mayor is authorized to execute all documents and make all agreements deemed necessary to complete this project in accordance with this resolution and project appropriations.

Section 6. That this resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
