RATIFYING A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH AND THE KENAI BOROUGH EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION FOR FISCAL YEARS 1986-87 THROUGH 1988-89.

WHEREAS, Section 3.04.280 of the Borough Code of Ordinances provides for the adoption of collective bargaining agreements by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Assembly, by Resolution 83-135, ratified the present collective bargaining agreement between the Borough and the Kenai Borough Employees Association, which will expire on June 30, 1986; and

WHEREAS, through good-faith negotiations, an agreement has been reached between the Borough and the Kenai Borough Employees Association regarding wages, benefits and other terms and conditions of employment for the fiscal years 1986-87 through 1988-89; and

WHEREAS, the collective bargaining agreement has been ratified by the Kenai Borough Employees Association, and the Administration recommends that the Assembly ratify the agreement for the Borough;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the collective bargaining agreement between the Borough and the Kenai Borough Employees Association effective July 1, 1986 through June 30, 1989, approved as Attachment A, is ratified and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
