RESOLUTION REGARDING THE VOLUNTARY USE OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS.

WHEREAS, United States Code, Title 5, Part 1, Chapter 5, Subchapter II, Section 552a (q), Disclosure of Social Security Number reads in part: "It shall be unlawful for any federal, state or local government agency to deny to any individual any right, benefit, or privilege provided by law because of such individual's refusal to disclose his social security account number" and "Any federal, state, or local government agency which requests an individual to disclose his social security account number shall inform that individual whether that disclosure is mandatory or voluntary, by what statutory or other authority such number is solicited, and what uses will be made of it."; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough now requests the social security account number without disclosing that such is mandatory or voluntary, by what statutory or other authority such number is solicited, and what uses will be made of it; and

WHEREAS, the existence of the federal government social security account number runs counter to the political philosophy of many residents within the Kenai Peninsula Borough;

NOW THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- Section 1. When the Kenai Peninsula Borough, or any of its subunits request an individual to disclose his social security account number it shall inform that individual in writing upon the face of the form upon which that number will be given that disclosure is mandatory or voluntary, by what statutory or other authority such number is solicited, and what uses will be made of it.
- Section 2. The mayor may assign a temporary number for the purposes of parcel identification.
- Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
