RESOLUTION 86-37

APPROVING CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS PREPARED BY ARCHITECT MCGLOTHLIN BALIVET FOR THE 1985 SCHOOL BOND RENOVATION AND NEW ADDITION TO THE SOLDOTNA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND AUTHORIZING BIDDING PHASE.

WHEREAS, at the regular election held in the Kenai Peninsula Borough on the 1st day of October, 1985 pursuant to Ordinance 85-51 of the Assembly placing the proposition on the ballot, the qualified electors of the Kenai Peninsula Borough authorized the issuance and sale of general obligation school bonds for the purpose of constructing and equipping school facilities within the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, Soldotna Elementary School renovation and new addition was included in the 1985 school bond issue; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough School Board recommended approval of construction documents for the 1985 school bond renovation and new addition to Soldotna Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, Assembly approval of construction documents and comprehensive cost for the renovation and addition to Soldotna Elementary School is required prior to bidding;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the construction documents and statement of probable cost, for construction of \$3,145,290.00 and probable total project cost of \$4,445,000.00 for the Soldotna Elementary School renovation and addition prepared by McGlothlin Balivet are approved.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with the bidding phase.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
