WHEREAS, the three months specified for the special task force established to review problems connected with school construction has been found to be insufficient; and


WHEREAS, it has been determined that the committee would benefit from having a member of the Board of Education serve on the committee;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the sunset date for the School Construction Task Force be extended to June 1, 1988.
