REQUESTING GOVERNOR COWPER TO ALLOCATE FUNDS IN THE GOVERNOR'S BUDGET FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW SEWARD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Board of Education has already requested state funding of a new elementary school in Seward; and

WHEREAS, with the opening of a new prison facility in the Spring of 1988, the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District has identified this project as the top facility concern within the Borough; and


WHEREAS, the existing Seward Elementary School enrollment already exceeds its capacity and portable classrooms will be required to meet needs prior to the expected influx of population when the prison opens;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That this resolution is intended as a statement of support of the request made by the Kenai Peninsula Borough Board of Education that the Governor allocate funds within his budget for construction of a new elementary school in Seward, Alaska.

Section 2. That this resolution be sent to the Honorable Steve Cowper, Governor of the State of Alaska.
