## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH RESOLUTION 87-119

PROVIDING FOR AN EXTENSION TO THE KENAI/SOLDOTNA SOLID WASTE MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT HELD BY ROBINSON CONSTRUCTION.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly has awarded a five year contract to Robinson Construction for the maintenance of the Kenai/Soldotna landfills; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 86-78 provided for a previous extension in an amount of eighteen months; and

WHEREAS, that five year contract with the eighteen (18) month extension is due to expire as of December 31, 1987; and

WHEREAS, the Waste Disposal Commission, the Administration, and the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly are in the process of establishing a new direction for the disposal of the Central Peninsula's solid wastes; and

WHEREAS, services may be procured without competitive bidding or proposals under KPB 5.28.280 where the borough requirements reasonably limit procurement to a sole source; and

WHEREAS, the circumstances warrant extension of this contract without competitive award; and

WHEREAS, Robinson Construction has offered to extend its present contract for the maintenance of the Kenai and Soldotna landfills; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has negotiated a time extension with the City of Kenai until November 30, 1988.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- Section 1. That the administration is authorized to issue an extension to the contract for an additional six (6) months to June 30, 1988.
- Section 2. The contract bid items will remain as bid in accordance with the terms of the contract and Resolution 86-78. The estimated amount of this extension is \$266,000.
- Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
