RESOLUTION 87-2

APPROVING THE INSTALLATION OF ONE ADDITIONAL MONITORING WELL DOWN GRADIENT OF THE SOLDOTNA LANDFILL SITE.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough exercises solid waste disposal powers on an area wide basis, which includes the operation of the Soldotna Landfill; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough has established a ground water monitoring program at the Soldotna Landfill in accordance with the Landfill's Solid Waste Disposal Permits; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Waste Disposal Commission upon reviewing the existing Soldotna ground water monitoring program, has recommended the installation of one additional monitoring well; and


WHEREAS, sufficient funds have been budgeted for in the current year Soldotna Landfill capital projects budget for the installation of one additional monitoring well.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:
