RESOLUTION 87-23

ACCEPTING A PROPOSAL FOR THE PREPARATION OF A CENTRAL SERVICES COST ALLOCATION PLAN FOR THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough has no cost data available to charge for overhead expenses to grants and other services; and

WHEREAS, it is becoming increasingly necessary to have this capability; and

WHEREAS, proposals were requested from qualified consultants to develop a central services cost allocation plan.

WHEREAS, all proposals were evaluated on the basis of scope and objectives of work to be performed, specific personnel, firm experience, and fixed fee; and

WHEREAS, the proposal presented by D. Griffith for a fixed fee of \$19,000 was judged to be in the best interest of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, funds are available for the implementation of this proposal in account 245.114030.43011;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to sign a contract with D. Griffith in an amount not to exceed \$19,000 to provide the Borough with a central services cost allocation plan.

Section 2. That this contract will be charged to account 245.114030.43011.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
