RESOLUTION 87-27(SBST)

URGING REVISION OF TENURE LAWS

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly anticipates further reductions in funds provided by the State of Alaska for many programs, including public education; and

WHEREAS, local governments will be making decisions on local taxes, staffing formulas, working conditions and employee wages and benefits related to revenue shortfalls; and

WHEREAS, the assembly believes that maintenance of educational programs is of the highest priority;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the legislature of the State of Alaska is urged to revise tenure laws in such a way as to allow reduction in force of school district employees and administrators due to loss or reduction of funds.


Section 2. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly supports House Bill 199.

Section 3. That copies of this resolution be distributed to Governor Cowper, Senate President Faiks, House Speaker Grussendorf, Senators Binkley, Fischer, Kerttula, Szymanski and Representatives Cato, Ellis, Koponen, Navarre, Swackhammer, Wallis and Zawacki.
