RESOLUTION 87-33

RESPONDING TO SCHOOL DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION'S CLEAR VIOLATION OF KPB 4.06.040 PROHIBITION ON USE OF PUBLIC MONIES TO ADVOCATE PASSAGE OF A BALLOT PROPOSITION.

WHEREAS, KPB 4.06.040 prohibits the use of public monies to promote the passage of a ballot proposition; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District administration expended school district funds for the materials and personnel time necessary to print up materials urging the passage of a ballot proposition on the October 1986 ballot;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the assembly hereby states its great concern that the intentional violation of KPB 4.06.040 by school district personnel is not only a violation of law and of the public trust, but also demonstrates to the district students a lack of respect for the law and public interest.

Section 2. That the assembly condemns these actions and violation of any borough ordinances by the school district administration and most strongly requests that the school district administration in the future adhere to requirements of the borough ordinances and consider reprimanding and noticing violators that such clear violation of borough ordinances will be included in the personnel record of all those involved for any future violation.

Section 3. That copies of this resolution be sent to the school board and to the Kenai Peninsula School District administration.
