AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE OFFSHORE FISHERIES BUSINESS TAX REVENUE SHARING PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough experiences significant impacts from the offshore fish processing industry; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough is an applicant to participate in the Offshore Fisheries Business Tax Revenue Sharing Pilot Project authorized by Chapter 98, SLA 1985; and


WHEREAS, the Resource Planning Department has evaluated all available information and determined as accurately as statistically possible the population increase reasonably related to the offshore fish processing industry; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough must pass a resolution adopting a population increase reasonably related to the offshore fish processing industry;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH THAT:

Section 1. The 1985 population increase reasonably related to the offshore fish processing industry as defined in the regulation was 7,643 persons.
