KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 87-40

REQUESTING THAT THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH SCHOOL DISTRICT AND CENTRAL ADMINISTRATORS TAKE THE INITIATIVE IN A VOLUNTARY WAGE REDUCTION

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough School Board requested a significant increase in local contribution to school operations; and

WHEREAS, a vast majority of the residents of the Kenai Peninsula Borough are experiencing a reduction in income from 5% to 30% with many also unemployed; and

WHEREAS, in order to reduce the budget without drastically affecting school programs, reductions in salaries need to take place; and


WHEREAS, it is also felt a voluntary wage reduction would help facilitate good faith bargaining in negotiations with certified employees;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly requests that the superintendent of the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District and central office administrators take the initiative in a voluntary wage reduction.

Section 2. That copies of this resolution be sent to the KPBSD Board of Education and the superintendent.
