RESOLUTION 87-44

URGING SUPPORT OF HOUSE BILL 156, GAS TAX INCREASES, PROVIDED THE ROAD MAINTENANCE FUNDING FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENTS IS FULLY FUNDED FROM THIS ADDITIONAL REVENUE.

WHEREAS, House Bill 156 of the Alaska Legislature proposes an eight cent (\$0.08) gas tax increase; and

WHEREAS, the revenue-sharing statutes under Title 29 provide for \$2,500 per mile for road maintenance for local government service areas; and

WHEREAS, this entitlement for road maintenance has not been fully funded in the past; and

WHEREAS, additional gasoline taxes should be utilized for road maintenance at the local level as well as at the state level;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1: That the assembly support passage of House Bill 156 with the \$0.08 per gallon gas tax increase, provided that the Alaska Legislature will commit to use of these funds to fully fund the \$2,500 per mile road maintenance program provided under the State revenue-sharing statutes in Title 29 of the Alaska Statutes. The assembly opposes passage of the increase in this tax unless such increase is used to fund the State revenue-sharing program for road maintenance.

Section 2: Copies of this resolution shall be sent to Governor Cowper, Senators Paul Fischer, Mike Szymanski, Jalmar Kerttula, and Representatives Mike Navarre and C.E. Swackhammer.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
