RESOLUTION 87-5

REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA TO SELECT CERTAIN LANDS WITHIN THE CHUGACH NATIONAL FOREST WHICH MEET THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 6(a) OF THE ALASKA STATEHOOD ACT.

WHEREAS, the state is eligible to select certain federal lands for a conveyance from within the Chugach National Forest the state pursuant to Section 6(a) of the Alaska Statehood Act; and

WHEREAS, certain available lands have been identified as being desirable for selection for community expansion and economic development; and

WHEREAS, these particular parcels have been leased to private individuals since 1950; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough feels the public can best be served by these parcels being turned over to private ownership;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough formally requests the State of Alaska to select the following described lands for conveyance from within the Chugach National Forest to the State of Alaska pursuant to Section 6(a) of the Alaska Statehood Act:


- A. Marty & June Arnoldy's special use permit located in T6N, R1W, SM, SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 5 comprising 7.3 acres.
- B. William Haas's special use permit shown as Upper Summit Lake Lot 1, comprising 1.70 acres.
- C. Charles Ellis's special use permit shown as Upper Summit Lake Lot 2, comprising 1.51 acres.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
