KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 87-58

RELINQUISHING THE BOROUGH'S NOMINATION OF STATE LANDS LOCATED WITHIN THE HOPE AIRPORT RESIDENCE GROUP.

WHEREAS, the Borough nominated for selection certain lands in the Hope area pursuant to KPB Resolution 78-124; and

WHEREAS, the Hope/Sunrise Advisory Planning Commission identified the area for small lot residential purposes in its community land use plan; and

WHEREAS, these certain lands are encumbered by established long term U. S. Forest Service leases; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has received tentative approval to these lands under the National Forest Community Grant; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the State of Alaska to offer these lands for sale to the permittees pursuant to AS 38.05.068 and AAC 67.052; and

WHEREAS, the KPB Planning Commission reviewed the relinquishment at its June 22, 1987 meeting and recommended the Borough's nomination of these lands be relinquished;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the relinquishment of the following described lands covered by Municipal Nomination ADL 201302 is hereby authorized:


Lots 1 through 28, HOPE AIRPORT RESIDENCE GROUP, located within a portion of Sections 3 and 4, T9N, R2W, S.M., Alaska, containing approximately 30 acres.


Section 2. That this relinquishment is made only in deference to the corresponding permittees.
