KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 87-65

AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE ASSEMBLY TO APPOINT A COMMITTEE TO OVERSEE ALL BOROUGH SCHOOL DEDICATIONS AND OTHER PRELIMINARY EVENTS.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough builds borough school facilities for the ultimate use of the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to provide for a more orderly transition from borough control to school district control of borough schools;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the president of the assembly is hereby authorized to appoint a committee to oversee: borough school dedications, openings, reopenings after renovations or additions; the placement and content of plaques, inscriptions or other fixtures to be attached on or to school buildings; and other such preliminary events involving borough school facilities.

Section 2. That it is the intent of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly to dedicate borough schools that were approved and funded by borough voters to the children of the borough; and the president of the assembly is authorized to direct the committee to remove any plaques, inscriptions or other fixtures from borough school facilities that state otherwise.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
