RESOLUTION 87-66

TRANSFERRING CENTRAL PENINSULA GENERAL HOSPITAL FUNDS TO PROVIDE FOR PURCHASE OF NEW-TECHNOLOGY ULTRASOUND EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, there has been a major advancement in ultrasound technology; and

WHEREAS, the availability and quality of obstetrical, surgical and medical care will be enhanced through purchase of new-technology ultrasound equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Central Peninsula General Hospital Service Area Board has identified a need in upgrading the ultrasound technology at Central Peninsula General Hospital; and


WHEREAS, funds are available in the construction account 490-811010-4999-85501 for transfer for such a purchase;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That \$100,000 be transferred from construction account 490-811010-4999-85501 to the movable equipment account 490-811010-48510.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
