## RESOLUTION 87-68 (SUBSTITUTE)

AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SURPLUS BOROUGH PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the borough school district has declared four protable classrooms at Kalifornsky Beach Elementary School surplus to its needs; and

WHEREAS, the assembly on August 4, 1970 adopted a memorandum outlining procedures for disposal of surplus property which required an appraisal of all property prior to disposal; and

WHEREAS, an appraisal requires the expenditures of time and monies far beyond its worth; and

WHEREAS, Homer Senior Citizens, Inc. has requested that the borough donate one of the portable classrooms for use as an adult day care center;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That provisions for the August 4, 1970 memorandum requiring appraisal of surplus property prior to disposal will be waived and sealed bids will be opened at 10:00 a.m., August 13, 1987.

Section 2. That the request for bids will be legally advertised in a newspaper of the borough at least ten (10) days prior to the bid opening.

Section 3. That the property to be disposed of will be on public display at the Kalifornsky Beach Elementary School.

Section 4. That one of the four portable classrooms will be retained as the assembly will be considering an ordinance to provide for the transfer of ownership of one portable classroom to Homer Senior Citizens, Inc. for use as an adult day care center in Homer.

Section 5. That bids will be received in the Kenai Peninsula Borough Finance Department prior to 10:00 a.m., August 13, 1987.

Section 6. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
