KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 87-86

CLASSIFYING BOROUGH LANDS IN SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 12 NORTH, RANGE 10 WEST, S.M. FOR LANDFILL PURPOSES AND AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH MAYOR TO SIGN DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE DEVELOPMENT OF A LANDFILL.

WHEREAS, there is a need to have a central consolidated solid waste disposal site in the Beluga area; and

WHEREAS, the proposed 40 acre site in Section 4, Township 12 North, Range 10 West, S.M. is consistent with the draft Chuitna Area Resource Development Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Planning Commission will consider this request on September 14, 1987 and a public meeting will be held on September 9, 1987 in the Beluga area to solicit public input; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has worked closely with the Department of Environmental Conservation, ARCO, Chugach Electric, CIRI, and Public Works to arrive at this proposed long term solution to an immediate problem;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That 40 acres in Section 4, Township 12 North, Range 10 West, S.M. is classified for solid waste management purposes.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to sign any and all documents necessary to effectuate this resolution and deemed to be in the best interests of the borough.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
