RESOLUTION 89-1

AUTHORIZING THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH TO ACT AS COGNIZANT AGENT FOR THE SOLDOTNA SENIOR CITIZENS IN THE RECEIPT OF A \$30,000 GRANT FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA AND TO PROVIDE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO MEET THEIR REPORTING AND COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS, the Soldotna Senior Citizens have received a \$30,000 state grant for funding for the planning and design of a Soldotna Senior Citizens' building; and

WHEREAS, the borough finance department currently accounts for grants and senior citizen funding; and


WHEREAS, technical assistance from the finance department is required for compliance with the reporting requirements;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the borough act as cognizant agent for the Soldotna Senior Citizens in the receipt of this grant.
