RESOLUTION 89-6

REQUESTING THAT THE LEGISLATURE USE THE RAILBELT ENERGY FUND FOR RAILBELT ENERGY PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the Railbelt Energy Fund was set aside for energy development and transmission needs of the railbelt area in Alaska; and

WHEREAS, there has been considerable discussion within the state about utilizing these funds for projects or operating expenses of the state other than railbelt energy projects; and

WHEREAS, the needs of the railbelt area for providing reliable energy area are critical; and


WHEREAS, diversion of these funds for other purposes may well jeopardize the future supply of energy needs within the railbelt area to the detriment of the future of Alaska;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. The Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough is opposed to the diversion or use of Railbelt Energy Funds to uses other than railbelt energy projects and needs. The assembly further urges that the legislature continue and expand a program of use of the Railbelt Energy Fund to meet the energy needs of the railbelt area of Alaska.

Section 2. That the clerk shall distribute copies of this resolution to the Honorable Steve Cowper, Governor of the State of Alaska, Senators Paul Fischer, Jay Kerttula, Mike Szymanski, and Representatives C. E. Swackhammer, Mike Navarre, Bette Cato, Jim Zawacki.
