KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 89-103

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT TO SET A MAXIMUM LIMIT FOR VENDORS TO BE REIMBURSED FOR CONDUCTING PULL-TAB ACTIVITIES ON THE BEHALF OF NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS

WHEREAS, Chapter 5.15 of the Alaska Statutes provides for the conduct and regulations of Games of Chance and Skill by non-profit organizations and these regulations govern the manner in which such games are conducted in the borough; and

WHEREAS, many non-profit organizations conduct gaming activities through vendors due to a lack of facilities and/or employees; and

WHEREAS, some vendors are believed to remit to non-profit organizations less than fifty percent (50%) of the ideal net; and

WHEREAS, the assembly feels that many beneficial and charitable non-profit organizations which provide needed community services within the borough at no cost to the taxpayers are heavily dependent upon gaming proceeds; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska and the Kenai Peninsula Borough is taxing gaming activities and thereby reducing the funds that return to the non-profit;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the Department of Commerce is hereby requested to establish a maximum limit of thirty percent (30%) of the ideal net that a non-profit organization can pay a vendor to conduct pull-tab activities on their behalf.

Section 2. That the borough clerk is directed to furnish a copy of this resolution to Randall P. Burns, Director, Division of Occupational Licensing; Senators Jay Kerttula, Mike Szymanski and Paul Fischer; and Representatives Jim Zawacki, Mike Navarre and C.E. Swackhammer; and Larry Mercurieff, Commissioner of Department of Commerce and Economic Development.
