RESOLUTION 89-108

DECLARING BOROUGH OWNED WALKWAY BRIDGES SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING DISPOSAL TO THE BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT

WHEREAS, under the 1981 State Assistance for Municipalities Program two metal walkway bridges were acquired and installed over the Resurrection River near Seward; and

WHEREAS, subsequent reconstruction of a portion of the Exit Glacier Road and a vehicular bridge eliminated the need for the foot bridges; and

WHEREAS, the bridges are currently stored in Seward, Alaska and no use for them has been identified; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Land Management, Alaska District Office in Anchorage has requested the bridges for public purposes in trail development;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That two metal walkway bridges currently stored in Seward, Alaska are declared surplus.

Section 2. That the two metal walkway bridges are authorized for disposal to the Bureau of Land Management, Alaska District Office, at no cost.

Section 3. That the Bureau of Land Management is responsible for removal from storage and transportation of the bridges to their site at no cost to the borough.

Section 4. That the borough makes no claim or statement regarding the condition or suitability of the bridges for the intended use.

Section 5. That the borough is held harmless of any liability in connection with removal, transportation or use of the bridges.

Section 6. That if the bridges are not removed by the Bureau of Land Management within one year from the date this resolution is adopted the bridges shall revert to the borough.

Section 7. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
