REQUESTING THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY TAKE ACTION TO DIRECT THE ADMINISTRATION TO DEVELOP A WORKABLE DRUG TESTING POLICY

WHEREAS, the welfare and safety of the public is the foremost concern of the members of the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area Board; and

WHEREAS, the national trend is toward a drug free society; and

WHEREAS, national statistics reflect significant increased costs and major liability exposure to governing bodies;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area Board urgently requests that the Kenai Peninsula Borough direct the administration to establish a workable mandatory drug testing policy by the end of the current fiscal year.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.
