KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 89-126

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO AWARD TWO CONTRACTS FOR DRILLING AND INSTALLATION OF GROUNDWATER MONITORING WELLS AT THE STERLING SPECIAL WASTE SITE.

WHEREAS, the borough requested separate proposals to perform drilling and installation of five monitoring wells in the confined aquifer and two wells in the unconfined aquifer at the closed Sterling Special Waste Site; and

WHEREAS, the proposal submitted by Kraxberger Drilling for \$108,492.50 to drill five confined aquifer monitoring wells is deemed the best proposal considering all qualifications, experience and price for the work; and

WHEREAS, the proposal submitted by Denali Drilling for \$20,830 to drill two unconfined aquifer monitoring wells is deemed the best proposal considering all qualifications, experience and price for the work;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the mayor is authorized to proceed with award of contract to Kraxberger Drilling for five monitoring wells at the Sterling Special Waste Site in an amount not to exceed \$108,492.50.

Section 2. The mayor is authorized to proceed with award of contract to Denali Drilling for two monitoring wells in the unconfined aquifer at the Sterling Special Waste Site in an amount not to exceed \$20,830. The mayor may delete the requirement for pumps on these wells as he deems appropriate to meet the needs of the borough.


Section 3. That expenditures for these contracts will be charged to account number 411.325010.49999.89651.

Section 4. That the mayor is authorized to execute all documents and make all agreements deemed necessary to carry out this resolution.


Section 5. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
