RESOLUTION 89-13

AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT-RURAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE (CDBG-REDI) PROGRAM TO FACILITATE BUILDING A PUBLIC MULTIPURPOSE DOCK IN PORT GRAHAM, ALASKA.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough wishes to assist the Village of Port Graham in providing a public multipurpose dock for use in the community; and

WHEREAS, this organization is an applicant for a grant in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) from the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs (hereinafter "DCRA"), under the CDBG-REDI program; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor of the Kenai Peninsula Borough is authorized to negotiate and execute any and all documents required for granting and managing funds under the CDBG-REDI program on behalf of the Village of Port Graham for the building of a public multipurpose dock facility. These include but are not limited to agreements between the Borough and the Village of Port Graham Council for the administration of and the meeting of program requirements.

Section 2. That the Mayor is also authorized to execute any subsequent amendments to said grant agreement to provide for adjustment to the project within the scope of services or tasks, based upon the needs of the project.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
