KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 89-130

REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA TO FUND AND CONDUCT A HYDROGEOLOGIC SURVEY IN THE CENTRAL PENINSULA AREA OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, the Alaska Water Resources Board held their semi-annual meeting in Soldotna and took testimony from industry and the concerned citizenry regarding groundwater quality in the Central Peninsula area; and

WHEREAS, that testimony served to reinforce the imminent need of a comprehensive hydrogeologic evaluation in the Central Peninsula; and

WHEREAS, HCR 13 and COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE SCR 15 addressing such surveys are awaiting passage in the upcoming legislative session; and

WHEREAS, the ADGGS has prepared a proposal specifically outlining a survey to be conducted in the Central Peninsula area; and


WHEREAS, it is in the best interest and welfare of the residents, industry and the Kenai Peninsula Borough that this survey begin in earnest at the earliest possible date.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Alaska Legislature is requested to provide adequate funding for the proposed hydrogeologic study and to support early passage of HCR 13 and COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE SCR 15.

Section 2. That the clerk shall send copies of this resolution to Gov. Cowper, Dennis Kelso, Commissioner of Dept. of Environmental Conservation; Lennie Gorsuch, Dept. of Natural Resources; Senators Szymanski, Kertulla, Binkley and Fischer and Representatives Navarre, Swackhammer, Wallis and Zawacki.
