KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 89-14

SUPPORTING HOUSE BILL 37 AND SENATE BILL 100 PROPOSALS ON SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION FUNDING IN ALASKA.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has funded school construction for elementary and secondary schools in the State under a variety of methods, including debt reimbursement, Department of Education grants and direct appropriations of the Alaska Legislature to municipalities; and

WHEREAS, this has led to problems in continued funding for existing bonded indebtedness for schools; and

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the State of Alaska to establish a consistent and equitable program to meet existing bonded indebtedness obligations for school construction in the State and provide for future facilities needs; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 37 and Senate Bill 100 would be a major step in establishing the consistency and equity needed in the program;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough supports the enactment of legislation as contained in the committee substitute for House Bill 37 (L&C) and Senate Bill 100 to establish a consistent and equitable program for school construction financing for the future and to provide for the handling of existing bonded indebtedness for school construction that was incurred under existing and prior debt reimbursement laws.


