RESOLUTION 89-15

DESIGNATING THE NEWSPAPER AND AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THE PROPERTY TAX FORECLOSURE LIST FOR THE TAX YEAR 1988 AND THE DELINQUENT PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX LIST

WHEREAS, the borough is required by statute to publish an annual foreclosure list setting forth the names and amounts of all delinquent real property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the assembly is required to designate the newspaper which will publish the foreclosure list and delinquency list and the times of publication; and

WHEREAS, the finance department estimates the contractor will be required to publish approximately 400 computer pages for the 1989 tax foreclosure list and approximately 165 computer pages for the personal property delinquency list; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Peninsula Clarion will perform all work necessary to print, publish, and distribute the foreclosure list for the 1988 tax year for an estimated unit price of \$72.60 per page of computer printout and the delinquent personal property tax list for a unit price of \$15.50 per page of computer printout.


The total contract price shall be determined by multiplying the number of computer printout pages which the contractor must publish by the bid price per page. The contract will be adjusted by any increase in postal rates that may take effect prior to final publication date. All expenditures for this contract shall be charged to account 100.114040.43310.


Section 2. That during the months of February and March, 1989, the foreclosure list will be published one time per week for four (4) consecutive weeks and the delinquent personal property list will be run one (1) time during (1) week.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
