KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 89-16 SUBSTITUTE

RECOGNIZING THE STERLING AREA SENIOR CITIZENS, INC., FOR THE PARTICIPATION IN THE BOROUGH'S SENIOR CITIZEN GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Sterling Area Senior Citizens, Inc., is a newly formed nonprofit organization of the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, KPB 5.22 provides funding for senior citizen organizations meeting the conditions of the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, there are 123 senior citizens of the Sterling area based on the 1984 census; and

WHEREAS, voters of the Kenai Peninsula Borough indicated support for funding of senior citizen programs; and

WHEREAS, the Sterling Area Senior Citizens, Inc., seek recognition of the Assembly to be eligible to receive senior citizen program funding from the Borough;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly recognizes the Sterling Area Senior Citizens, Inc., as a senior citizen organization eligible to participate in senior citizen funding by the Kenai Peninsula Borough under Chapter 5.22 of the Borough Code.

Section 2. The area served by this organization is the Sterling precinct for purposes of determining the allocation of funds for this group and all others funded under the ordinance.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
