RESOLUTION 89-23

DECLARING A 1985 CHEVROLET CELEBRITY FOUR DOOR SEDAN, SERIAL NO. 1G1AW19XXF6211407, LICENSE NO. XXN118 BELONGING TO THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SAME.

WHEREAS, the Director of Maintenance of the Kenai Peninsula Borough was involved in an auto accident on December 1, 1988, resulting in damage to the vehicle in excess of the current market value; and

WHEREAS, salvage bids have been solicited and two bids received, one for \$900.50 from K-Beach Auto Body and the other for \$875.00 from Jackson's Sales and Service; and

WHEREAS, more revenue will probably be realized from the sale of the vehicle at this time rather than from auction; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Assembly, on August 4, 1970, adopted a memorandum outlining procedures for disposal of surplus property which requires an appraisal of all property prior to disposal unless otherwise provided by the Assembly;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the 1985 Chevrolet, VIN #1G1AW19XXF6211407 is declared surplus property of the Kenai Peninsula Borough, and sale to the highest bidder for the salvage, K-Beach Auto Body in the amount of \$900.50, is authorized.


Section 2. That the proceeds from the sale of said vehicle be deposited to the Insurance and Litigation fund of the Risk Management Division of the Department of Finance.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
