WHEREAS, the Homer Council is recognized as a center for the arts throughout the State; and


WHEREAS, the HCOA is planning the establishment of a summer jazz festival and a summer youth arts program;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:
