RESOLUTION 89-32

REQUESTING THE NAMING OF A NIKISKI BRIDGE "CLINT STARNES MEMORIAL BRIDGE"

WHEREAS, members of the Nikiski community and City of Kenai have requested that the Assembly support the naming of the Swanson River bridge (as yet unnamed) in the Captain Cook Park area the Clint Starnes Memorial Bridge; and

WHEREAS, Clint Starnes was a senior at Kenai Central High School and an employee of Frontier Foods in Nikiski at the time of his tragic death in October of 1987; and

WHEREAS, Clint spent much of his time camping and fishing on the Swanson River; and

WHEREAS, it would be appropriate to name the bridge in memory and honor of Clint Starnes; and


WHEREAS, naming of the bridge needs to be performed by the Alaska State Legislature at the request of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the Alaska State Legislature is hereby requested to name the Swanson River bridge in the Captain Cook State Park in memory of Clint Starnes so that it shall be officially known as "Clint Starnes Memorial Bridge."

Section 2. That the Clerk is directed to furnish a copy of this resolution to Senators Mike Symanski, Jay Kerttula and Paul Fischer, and Representatives Jim Zawacki, Mike Navarre and C. E. Swackhammer, and Mark S. Hickey, Commissioner of the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities.
