RESOLUTION 89-36

APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF SOLDOTNA TO DEVELOP AND PRODUCE MAPS ON THE BOROUGH'S GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough has a geographic information system which is capable of providing detailed information on maps; and

WHEREAS, to produce maps the information must be developed through survey so the information can be placed in the GIS; and

WHEREAS, the City of Soldotna desires to develop accurate mapping data within the City of Soldotna and has solicited proposals to gather survey and other information necessary for digital mapping on the GIS system of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Borough wish to enter into an agreement whereby the City will pay for the survey and mapping work and the Borough will install the data on the GIS as well as administering the surveying and mapping contract to provide for smooth integration of the data into the system;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the Assembly approves a mapping agreement between the Borough and the City of Soldotna in substantially the form attached to this resolution (labeled March 23, 1989 Draft). The Mayor is authorized to sign the agreement in that form or with such modifications to the language regarding indemnity as he deems in the best interest of the Borough.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
