AUTHORIZING THE SELECTION OF LANDS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA PURSUANT TO THE MUNICIPAL ENTITLEMENT ACT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING LANDS FOR DEVELOPMENT OF A DRILLING MUD DISPOSAL SITE IN THE VICINITY OF TRADING BAY BY MARATHON OIL COMPANY

WHEREAS, on July 18, 1988, the borough planning commission held a public hearing in Nikiski concerning the location of a drilling mud disposal site proposed by Marathon Oil Company and found the proposed use was noxious, hazardous and injurious and denied the issuance of a permit; and

WHEREAS, the borough planning commission recommended that the borough provide assistance in locating a suitable site for the disposal of drilling mud; and

WHEREAS, Marathon Oil Company has been actively seeking a site on the west side of Cook Inlet in the vicinity of their Trading Bay facility to be used for the disposal of drilling muds; and

WHEREAS, a suitable area for a disposal site has been located on lands owned by the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the outcome of discussions with the State of Alaska indicated that the method for Marathon Oil Company to obtain these lands is that the borough should select the land; and

WHEREAS, the borough planning commission reviewed this proposed selection at its meeting of April 3, 1989, and recommended that the lands be selected,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough is authorized to file a selection for the following described lands:


E1/2 of Section 36, Township 9 North, Range 15

acres, more or less.

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
Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to sign any documents necessary to effectuate this resolution and deemed to be in the best interest of the Borough.
