RESOLUTION 89-51

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO GRANT AN EXTENSION TO METCO, INC./SEWARD SERVICE FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS OF THE SEWARD LANDFILL

WHEREAS, the five year contract to Metco, Inc./Seward Service for the Seward Landfill maintenance, is due to expire June 30, 1989; and

WHEREAS, the administration is in the process of establishing a new direction for the disposal of solid wastes in the Seward area; and

WHEREAS, services may be procured under KPB Ordinance 87-29 5.28.280 and 5.28.300 where the mayor may waive formal bidding procedures when the best interests of the borough will be served by such action; and

WHEREAS, Metco, Inc./Seward Services has offered to extend its present contract for the maintenance of the Seward Landfill; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has recommended extending the contract for a six month period;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the administration is authorized to issue a change order to the contract to extend its time for an additional six (6) months to December 31, 1989, and increasing the cost of "Covering Solid Waste" by 13 percent of the original bid item. All other contract items will remain as bid in accordance with the terms of the contract and Resolution 84-100.

Section 2. The estimated amount of this extension is Thirty Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000) and all funds for the maintenance of the Seward Landfill will be charged to account 100-321050-43011.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
