RESOLUTION 89-53

RATIFYING A NEW COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1989 BETWEEN THE BOROUGH AND THE KENAI BOROUGH EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, Section 3.04.280 of the Borough Code of Ordinances provides for the adoption of collective bargaining agreements by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Assembly, by Resolution 86-126, ratified a collective bargaining agreement between the borough and the Kenai Borough Employees Association which will expire on June 30, 1989; and

WHEREAS, through good-faith negotiations, an agreement has been reached between the borough administration and the Kenai Borough Employees Association regarding wages, benefits and other terms and conditions of employment beginning July 1, 1989; and


WHEREAS, the collective bargaining agreement has been ratified by the membership of the Kenai Borough Employees Association, and the borough administration recommends that the assembly ratify the agreement for the borough;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the collective bargaining agreement between the borough and the Kenai Borough Employees Association effective July 1, 1989 is ratified and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
