RESOLUTION 89-59

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT WITHIN A BOROUGH  
RIGHT-OF-WAY

WHEREAS, Wayne Fellers Subdivision Spearin 1977 Addition, Resubdivision of Tracts 2 and 4, Plat No. 78-101 as filed on June 12, 1978 dedicated sixty foot wide public rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, access to the Kasilof River for a buried pipeline for wastewater discharge from a fisheries processing plant is essential for continued operation; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission recommended adoption of Resolution 89-XX at its May 1, 1989 meeting;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the mayor is authorized to grant a special use permit for a buried pressurized wastewater discharge pipeline to Inlet Fisheries, Inc. within the dedicated road rights-of-way of Leigh Street, Sandwich Drive and Amber Drive as platted within Wayne Fellers Subdivision Spearin 1977 Addition, Resubdivision of Tracts 2 and 4.


Section 2. That buried pipeline shall be constructed to engineer specifications and proper permits and notifications shall be obtained but not limited to the Environmental Protection Agency, Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation, the Alaska Department of Fish and Game, the Alaska Department of Natural Resources, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Homer Electric Association, Enstar Natural Gas Inc., and Telephone Utilities of the Northland. The mayor may impose additional terms and conditions as he deems reasonably necessary to protect the interests of the borough.

Section 3. That the location of buried pipeline shall be subject to approval by the planning and public works departments of the borough and a copy of an as-built plan be furnished to each department upon completion of construction.

Section 4. That the mayor is authorized to sign such documents necessary to affectuate this permit.

Section 5. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
