RESOLUTION 89-61

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A SPECIAL LAND USE PERMIT ON BOROUGH  
PATENTED LANDS

WHEREAS, the borough has selected and received Patent #5510 to lands in the Beluga River area on the west side of Cook Inlet; and

WHEREAS, these lands comprise uplands adjacent to lakes and rivers historically used for recreational purposes; and

WHEREAS, a certain registered guide has requested the borough to grant a special land use permit for a headquarter site for commercial hunting and fishing operations; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Planning Commission recommended the subject permit be approved at its May 15, 1989 meeting;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the borough grant a special land use permit for + 1.08 acres adjacent to Viapan Lake lying just south of Lot 1, Viapan Dena Subdivision, Plat No. 85-263 all within Section 17, Township 12 North, Range 10 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska.

Section 2. That the term of the special land use permit will be for an initial period of one (1) year with an option to renew the permit in one year (1) increments for a total of five (5) years.

Section 3. That the annual permit fee shall be \$250.00 dollars payable to the Kenai Peninsula Borough.

Section 4. That the mayor is authorized to sign such documents necessary to effectuate this permit and yearly extensions to the permit if it is in the best interest of the borough.

Section 5. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
