RESOLUTION 89-75

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO AWARD A CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE NIKISKI PEDESTRIAN SAFETY PATHS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Finance Department has solicited bids for the Nikiski Pedestrian Safety Paths Improvements Phase 2; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by Foster Construction, is fair and reasonable and the bidder qualified to undertake this project according to the terms and conditions of the contract documents; and

WHEREAS, funding shall be provided from Grant No.88-605 and from Grant No. 89-710 for construction of this project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That a contract is awarded to Foster Construction in the amounts indicated below:




Section 2. That an additional amount may be spent to pave a connecting strip or path between the entrance and exit of the schools as long as the cost does not go beyond funds budgeted for the project.

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to execute all documents and make all arrangements deemed necessary to complete this project in accordance with this resolution and the project appropriations.

Section 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
