RESOLUTION 89-85

DECLARING A SUBMERGIBLE HYDRAULIC SCRUBBER LOCATED AT THE NORTH PENINSULA RECREATION SERVICE AREA POOL BUILDING AS SURPLUS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DISPOSAL BY AUCTION

WHEREAS, the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area has no further use for a submergible hydraulic scrubber located in the Nikiski pool building, and the service area board has declared that the scrubber is surplus to the service area's needs; and

WHEREAS, KPB 5.28.500(B) authorizes the sale of obsolete and surplus tangible property by sealed bid or public auction;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the submergible hydraulic scrubber located in the Nikiski pool building is declared as surplus.

Section 2. That this surplus scrubber shall be disposed of by sealed bid sale to the highest bidder.


Section 3. That the proceeds of this sale shall go into the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area account No. 225.37110.

Section 4. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
