RESOLUTION 89-86

DECLARING SILICA SAND OWNED BY THE NORTH PENINSULA RECREATION SERVICE AREA AS SURPLUS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DISPOSAL BY AUCTION

WHEREAS, nine pallets of seventy grit silica sand purchased for sandblasting the North Peninsula Pool did not produce the required results; and

WHEREAS, the North Peninsula Service Area does not have a need or use for the seventy grit sand; and

WHEREAS, the North Peninsula Service Area would like to regain some or all of the expense of this sand;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That nine pallets of seventy grit silica sand owned by the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area are declared surplus.

Section 2. That this surplus sand shall be disposed of by sealed bid sale to the highest bidder.


Section 3. That the proceeds of the sale of this surplus property shall go into the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area account number 225.37110.

Section 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
