RESOLUTION 89-87

SETTING THE BALLOT PROPOSITION FOR BOND APPROVAL FOR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AND TRANSFER FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the Assembly adopted Ordinance 89-83 authorizing issuance of \$4,662,000.00 in general obligation bonds to finance Borough solid waste and transfer facilities; and

WHEREAS, voter approval of those bonds is both desirable and required;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the following proposition be placed before all voters at the municipal election to be held October 3, 1989:


Proposition 1: Approving \$4,662,000.00 in Bonded Indebtedness for Solid Waste Facilities. Do you approve the issuance of up to \$4,662,000.00 in general obligation bonds of the Kenai Peninsula Borough for the purpose of design, construction, closeout and purchase of sites, facilities and equipment for solid waste disposal and transfer at Seward and Soldotna, and pledging the full faith and credit of the Borough for repayment of such indebtedness?
