RESOLUTION 89-98

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO AWARD A WATER MONITORING/TESTING CONTRACT FOR SOLID WASTE FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the borough requested proposals to perform water monitoring/testing for borough solid waste facilities; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 89-80 authorized the award of contract to the successful proposer, Northern Testing Laboratories of Anchorage, in the amount of \$40,000; and

WHEREAS, the requirement for \$500,000 professional liability insurance has not been fulfilled by Northern Testing Laboratories as required in the contract documents and request for proposals; and

WHEREAS, the second low proposer, Northern Test Labs of Soldotna, meets the insurance requirements and qualifies for the work to be performed; and

WHEREAS, funds are available in the Solid Waste Administration Water Sample Testing account to accomplish the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That Resolution 89-80 authorizing award of contract to Northern Testing Laboratories is rescinded and that the Mayor is authorized to award a contract to the second low proposer Northern Test Lab in the amount of \$48,000 for the Solid Waste Facilities Water Quality Monitoring Program for the period September 5, 1989 to June 30, 1990.


Section 2. That all expenditures for this project will be charged to accounts No.100-320010-43015 and No.100-323010-43015.

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to execute all documents and make all agreements deemed necessary to carry out this resolution.

Section 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
