KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 90-5

AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH TO ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION FOR WINTER AND SPRING OIL SPILL RESPONSE ACTIVITIES AND TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS OF UP TO \$1,831,000 FOR THAT PURPOSE

WHEREAS, the Mayor has executed an agreement for a grant from the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation for winter and spring response for the Exxon Valdez oil spill; and

WHEREAS, that grant provides for reimbursement for up to \$1,831,000 for response activities with an advance for first month expenses; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for the Borough to accept this grant and assist in providing winter and spring response activities;

WHEREAS, the appropriation made by Ordinance 89-22 needs to be increased by that amount;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly ratifies the Mayor's action in executing the winter oil spill response agreement with the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (a copy of which is attached to and incorporated in this resolution) and accepts the grant of up to \$1,831,000 for the activities specified under the agreement. The Mayor is authorized to carry out the activities under that agreement subject to any necessary appropriations.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
