RESOLUTION 90-8

AMENDING THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT TO ALLOW HAZARDOUS DUTY PAY FOR CERTIFIED PAINTERS ENGAGED IN HAZARDOUS PAINTING

WHEREAS, Resolution 89-123 required painters to become certified for hazardous painting as required by 8 AAC 61.800; and

WHEREAS, Article 23, Section 10 of the current collective bargaining agreement allows hazardous duty pay for asbestos removal; and

WHEREAS, the association has requested that certified painters receive hazardous duty pay for the hours they are engaged in actual hazardous painting as defined by state code; and

WHEREAS, the administration is amenable to this request; and

WHEREAS, the cost of this change will be minimal and will require no additional appropriations to implement; and

WHEREAS, a change to the collective bargaining agreement must be approved by the assembly;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That Article 23, Section 10 of the collective bargaining agreement effective July 1, 1989-June 30, 1992 is amended as follows:

Employees required to participate in asbestos removal will be compensated at seven (7) per cent over the Employee's basic rate as established by this article for all hours so engaged. Such work must be for projects for the removal of friable asbestos where Federal requirements to provide protective clothing and devices apply. This provision does not apply to encapsulation work. Certified painters required to engage in hazardous


painting under 8 AAC 61.800 will also receive hazardous duty pay for the actual hours so engaged.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect retroactively to January 1, 1990.
