RECLASSIFYING BOROUGH PATENTED LAND DESCRIBED AS LOT 1 STERLING
FIRE STATION FROM "SCHOOL PURPOSES" TO "PUBLIC USE" AND APPROVING
THE USE FOR THE RIDGEWAY/STERLING FIRE SERVICE AREA

WHEREAS, the Sterling Fire Station is located on a parcel of
land described as Lot 2, Sterling Fire Station; and

WHEREAS, the Ridgeway/Sterling Fire Service Area desires to
utilize the adjacent parcel described as Lot 1, Sterling Fire
Station for development of a training facility for emergency
services; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough School Board, at its
meeting of January 15, 1990, reviewed and approved the proposed
reclassification; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Planning Commission
reviewed the reclassification request at its meeting of January
22, 1990 and did not recommend reclassification;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the borough patented lands described as Lot
1, Sterling Fire Station, located within Section 11, T5N, R9W,
Seward Meridian, Alaska, are hereby reclassified from "School
Purposes" to "Public Use" and approved for use by the
Ridgeway/Sterling Fire Service Area.

Section 2. That this resolution shall become effective upon
adoption.
