RESOLUTION 90-110

CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE OCTOBER 2, 1990 REGULAR BOROUGH ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the Cavassing Board of the Kenai Peninsula Borough met on October 8, 1990 and tallied the votes of Questioned and Absentee ballots together with votes counted on election night and write-ins; and

NOW THEREFORE, THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
DECLARES:

Section 1: That in the Borough-wide election for Mayor, Don Gilman was elected, having received the highest vote tallies.

Section 2: That in the Borough-wide election for School District, Seat A, Cliff Massie; Seat B, Marilyn Dimmick; Seat C, Joe Arness, and Seat E MariAnne Gross were elected having received the highest vote tallies and in excess of the required forty (40%) percent of the vote.

Section 3: That in Assembly District 1, Seat A, James W. Skogstad was elected having received the highest vote tallies and in excess of the forty (40%) percent vote.

Section 4: That in Assembly District 2, Seat A, no candidate received highest vote tallies and in excess of the required forty (40%) percent of the vote.

Section 5: That in Assembly District 2, Seat E, no candidate received the required 40% and in addition, a Notice of Request for Recount has been received.

Section 6: That in Assembly District 3, Seat B, Jack Brown was elected having received the highest vote tallies and in excess of the required forty (40%) percent of the vote.

Section 7: That in Assembly District 3, Seat C, Mark Hodgins was elected having received the highest vote tallies and in excess of the required forty (40%) percent of the vote.

Section 8: That in Assembly District 4, Seat A, Burt Anderson was elected having received the highest vote tallies and in excess of the required forty (40%) percent of the vote.

Section 9: That in the Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Service Area, Seat E, Carol Mead was election to a 3 year term.

Section 10: That in the Bear Creek Fire Service Area, Seat E, Rock Elhard was elected to a 3 year term, and Seat C, Carol R. Henderlong was elected to a 1 year term.

Section 11: That in the Central Peninsula Emergency Medical Service Area, Seat A, Ty Clark was elected to a 3 year term, Seat B, Al Bishop was elected to a 3 year term, and Seat D. Linda HJoeger was elected to a 2 year term.

Section 12: That in the Kalifonsky Fire Service Area, Seat C, David Silva was election to a 1 year term, Seat D, John Fairchild was elected to a 3 year term, and Seat A, Martin Hall was elected to a 1 year term.

Section 13: That in the Nikiski Fire Service Area, Seat F,

Bernie Smith was elected to a 3 year term, Seat G, Sandra Traxinger was elected to a 3 year term, and Seat E, Fred Newton was elected to a 1 year term.

Section 14: That in the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area, Seat E, Annette Cameron O'Connell was elected for a 3 year term.

Section 15: That in the Ridgeway/Sterling Fire Service Area, Seat C, Walter H. Ward was elected to a 3 year term, Seat D Tom Hodel was elected to a 3 year term, Seat E, Frank Christensen was elected to a 1 year term.

Section 16: That in the South Peninsula Hospital Service Area, Seat D, Mary T. McAnelly was elected to a 3 year term, Seat E, Leroy Gannaway was elected to a 3 year term, Seat F, Thomas Zitzmann was elected to a 3 year term, and Seat A, Charles H. (Charlie) Davis Jr. was elected to a 1 year term.

Section 17: That in the Central Road Maintenance Service area Seat A, Ray M. Posey was elected to a 3 year term, Seat B, Williams Phillips was elected to a 3 year term, Seat E, Al White was elected to a 1 year term.

Section 17: That in the East Road Maintenance Service Area Seat A, Ken Baysinger was elected to a 3 year term, Seat B Bob Ferguson was elected to a 3 year term, and Seat D, John Tracy was elected to a 2 year term.

Section 18: That in the North Road Maintenance Service Area Seat A, Dean Rounds was elected to a 3 year term, Seat B, Richard McGahan was elected to a 3 year term, and Seat D, Alan J. Bute was elected to a 2 year term.

Section 19: That in the South Road Maintenance Service Area Seat A, Michael Cuffe was elected to a 3 year term, Seat B, Dick Gregoire was elected to a 3 year term, and Seat E, G. Eischems was elected to a 1 year term.

Section 20: That in the non-areawide vote, Proposition #1 authorizing the assembly to remove restrictions on hiring and expenditures from the non-areawide port and harbor powers of the Kenai Peninsula Borough, failed by the voters outside the cities.

Section 21: That in the areawide vote, Proposition #2, providing for areawide authority of the Kenai Peninsula Borough to fund postsecondary education programs provided by colleges in the University of Alaska system located in the Kenai Peninsula Borough subject to a one-tenth of a mill tax levy limit, was approved by the voters areawide.


Section 22: That in the non-areawide vote, Proposition #3 raising the mill rate cap of the Central Peninsula Emergency Medical Service Area from 1 mill to 1.5 mills, failed approval by

the non-areawide voters.
